Abstract

This document describes the instructions to prepare an abstract for the 11th Asian Symposium on Precision Forging (ASPF2010). These instructions are written in the format your abstract should appear. Please read and follow them very carefully. The official language is English. The abstract must have a maximum length of **one page**.

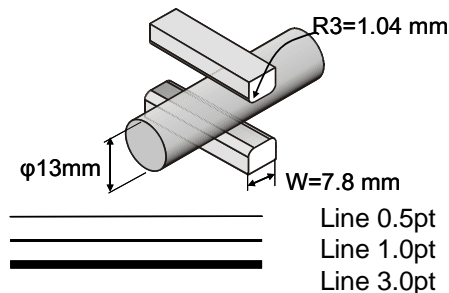


Figure 1: Example of figure.

The abstract must include maximum five keywords. The abstract may include maximum one figure to be inserted in the text as shown in **Figure 1**. Relevant references may also be included and indicated in the text using consecutive numbers in square bracket, as [1], [2,3], [1-3].

Please submit your abstract by E-mail: paper@aspf2010.org before **May 31, 2010**. Do not send your abstract by mail or fax. You can select presentation methods, oral or poster. Your presentation method which you select must be described in your abstract or E- mail. However organizing committee keeps the right to change the methods considering paper number and capacity of the venue.
