## **ICFG International Paper Prize 2005**

### **The Purpose**

The International Cold Forging Group has established the ICFG International Prize to honor young R&D workers of outstanding merit in the field. Candidates should be authors of original R&D meeting the objectives of ICFG, i.e.: to promulgate the economic advancement of cold forging by disseminating knowledge of relevant processes and sciences. Candidates should not be older than 35 at the end of the year in which they submit their application.

### **The Application**

Applicants for the ICFG International Prize 2005 must submit the following to the ICFG secretariat (see address below) not later than **May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005**:

- Original scientific paper dealing with cold forging and related topics (max. 6 pages)
- Scientific Curriculum Vitae
- List of publications
- Letter of recommendation by a member of the ICFG

### **The Selection**

Two members of the ICFG, representing two countries (not the candidate's), will assess the papers and submitted documents. Based on their assessment, the Advisory Board will appoint a winner.

### **The Prize**

The ICFG International Prize, consisting of a certificate and a cash prize, will be awarded to the winner at the ICFG Plenary Meeting in Chester / UK in September 2005. The prize winner will be asked to present his paper to the General Assembly there. The paper submitted will be published in the magazine WIRE.

# ICFG - Young Researchers International Exchange Prize 2005

## Motivation

The "ICFG - Young Researchers International Exchange Prize" is established in order to support the understanding of young researchers of the importance of cold and warm forging production as it is carried out by world leading companies and also to give young researchers an understanding of social and cultural differences and challenges in overseas countries.

## Scope of Prize

This year the prize will be given for the first time. The technical trip is scheduled for September 18, 2005 to September 27, 2005 (10 days) and will cover visits to a light metal cold forging company, coating company machine tool manufacturer, cold-warm-hot forger, cold forger as well as academic institutions in Germany, Switzerland and Liechtenstein. Also some cultural activities are planned. 4 to 6 young researchers will be granted the prize. For this year, the prize winners have to cover their transportation costs to/from Frankfurt-Airport (Germany) themselves. All remaining expenses during the technical trip will be covered by the ICFG and the sponsors. The ICFG asks for applications until May 20, 2005.

## Who can apply?

Any young researcher working on cold and/or warm forging fulfilling the following requirements can apply:

- The applicant should be promoted by an ICFG-member.
- The applicant should have an outstanding education and/or research performance.
- The applicant should be less than 30 years old at the time of application.
- The applicant should have completed at least his/her master-of-science study.
- The applicant may be a research assistant at a university or be employed in industry or a research institute.
